ADDENDUM: MISCELLANEOUS RELEVANT EXPERIENCE

MULTI-SPECIES EXPERIENCE

Dogs – I've trained many different breeds and mixes, large, small, and giant, both in my capacity as a professional trainer for more than 18 years and in my private life. I've also trained other people to train dogs and coached & supervised other professional trainers. I've trained & entertained hundreds of group classes.

Horses – I worked for a livery stable in Montgomery, AL (Fisher Farms) from the age of 12 through high school graduation, caring for and maintaining their working horses, including all feeding, grooming tasks, mucking stalls, exercise (including riding), equipment care and cleaning, and training. I have owned my own horses and daily performed all care and enrichment duties for them. I have also cared for other hoof stock, including goats and sheep.

Chickens – I have trained many chickens at the Bob Bailey Operant Conditioning Chicken Workshops under the supervision of Drs. Bob Bailey and Parvene Farhooody. I trained various chickens to perform such tasks as to run an agility course, complete an obstacle course, "moonwalk", spin, make color and shape discriminations, peck on cue, go out & return on cue, and more (Chicken training demonstration video – <https://youtu.be/d5O-Y4er4TE>).

Marine Mammals – I have trained sea lions, dolphins, and manatees at the Riveria Maya Dolphin Discovery facility

Cats – I have cared for, trained, created enrichment for cats in a professional setting. Taught a place cue to a cat.

Rats – I've worked with several rats who've ended up on the Broadway stage (on purpose). I've trained rats to target, and I've cared for and fed lab rats.

Ferrets – I owned a ferret who I litter-box trained and taught to come when called.

Snakes – I've socialized snakes and helped them become accustomed to human handling.

Chinchillas - I've socialized chinchillas and helped them become accustomed to human handling.

Fish – I have owned and cared for various fresh water fish over my lifetime.

INTERNSHIPS

Pat Miller – I have completed and also assisted with several of Pat's Peaceable Paws Academies and Workshops, including Level One Instructors' Course and Reactive Rover Aggression workshops. Duties included coaching workshop attendees and transporting and working with the dogs. I am one of her certified trainers.

John Rogerson - Intensive Course: I spent three weeks in India training with John. We worked with dogs and later, with their owners helping to transfer new behaviors. I also worked with narcotics detection dogs. Trainers formed teams to compete with dogs we'd trained to such tasks as a running wait, out of sight recall, water retrieve, tracking, and detection work. My team placed *highest in all tasks* except water retrieval (we placed second).

Sue Sternberg – Attended multiple Sternberg seminars, including a week-long animal shelter internship & learned Sue's Train to Adopt, Assess-A-Pet, & Training Wheels programs, working with shelter dogs, many displaying aggressive behaviors.

Emory University Laboratory Animals – I worked for Emory University caring for their lab rat population of a few hundred rats, cleaning cages, feeding, and watering them daily and to exacting standards.
